



## Instructions

This declaration may be completed as part of the import permit application for dogs and cats being imported to Australia from approved group 3 countries. If the application is completed as specified, the animal may be eligible for a ten day post entry quarantine (PEQ) period; if not completed, the animal will require at least a thirty day PEQ period.

This document must be forwarded to the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry at [catdogidcheck@aff.gov.au](mailto:catdogidcheck@aff.gov.au) by the official government veterinarian or a government employed biosecurity officer/inspector from the Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority. The email must include the following information in the subject line: Importer surname, importer first name, animal name, microchip number, country of export (e.g. Smith, John, Spot 123456789, The Netherlands). The department will not accept identification declarations from any other source.
