## 1 DOEL EN TOEPASSINGSGEBIED

Deze instructie geldt voor de tijdelijke en permanente export van paarden naar de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten. De instructie beschrijft de voorwaarden die worden gesteld aan de import in de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten, de controles die de NVWA hiervoor moet uitvoeren, en de gegevens die het bedrijfsleven moet aanleveren aan de NVWA.

Over de certificeringseisen die gelden voor de tijdelijke en permanente export van paarden naar de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten zijn officiële bilaterale afspraken gemaakt. Deze afspraken zijn bindend, van deze afspraken kan dus niet worden afgeweken.

## 4 WERKWIJZE

- Raadpleeg vooraf de instructie Tijdelijke Maatregelen Derde Landen (TMDL-01) op mogelijke exportbeperkingen. Als in de TMDL-01 informatie staat die in strijd is met een landeninstructie dan is de informatie vermeld in de TMDL-01 leidend.
- Het certificaat is van toepassing op paarden die rechtstreeks van het bedrijf van oorsprong worden vervoerd naar het vliegveld, zonder tussendoor uitgeladen te worden. Het 'supplementary document' is dan ook niet van toepassing en dient niet te worden ondertekend.

Ook voor paarden die in andere landen zijn gecertificeerd dient het 'supplementary document' niet te worden ondertekend.

- Na het certificeren van het paard wordt een schets (certificaatnummer 802027) opgemaakt (handleiding: zie bijlage 5 van werkvoorschrift PRDUV-12). Dit is noodzakelijk voor de import permit van de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten.
  - Indien paarden van het USA-team, die in de Verenigd Staten zijn gecertificeerd voor export naar de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten (voor deelname aan de Longines League of Nations 2024 in Abu Dhabi) bij doorvoer langer dan 36 uur in Nederland verblijven, dient het '*Supplemental Health Certificate for U.S. Origin Horses that Temporarily Reside in Multiple Countries of Different CEM, Screwworm, and FMD Disease Status for No More Than 90 days Preceding Return to the United States*' te worden afgegeven (bijlage 5). Dit document dient te worden ondertekend door een officiële NVWA-dierenarts. Voor niet-Amerikaanse paarden die gaan deelnemen aan de Longines League of Nations 2024 in Abu Dhabi dient naast het certificaat voor de tijdelijke export tevens het '*Supplemental Health Certificate for the Temporary Importation of Foreign Origin Horses to the United States Under CEM Waiver 9 CFR 93.301(f) for Longines League of Nations 2024 in Ocala, FL and Longines Global Champions Tour 2024 in Miami, FL*' (bijlage 6) te worden afgegeven. Dit document dient te worden ondertekend door de certificerende NVWA-dierenarts.
- Voor beide documenten geldt dat deze op blanco papier mogen worden geprint.
- Diagnostische laboratoriumtesten dienen te worden uitgevoerd door een laboratorium welk conform het [werkvoorschrift K-O&O-IE-WV05](#) is toegestaan.

#### **4.1 Tijdelijke export**

##### Verklaring 1:

*It has been examined within 24 hours of export and are certified for freedom from clinical signs of external parasites as well as clinical signs of infectious and contagious diseases;*

##### Verklaring 2:

*If all the animals of species susceptible to the disease located on the holding have been slaughtered and the premises disinfected, the period of prohibition has been 30 days, beginning on the day on which the animals were destroyed and the premises disinfected, except in the case of Anthrax, where the period of prohibition is 15 days;*

**Verklaring 6:**

*As far as can be ascertained, and based on a written declaration by the owner/agent, it has been resident in the European Union for at least 21 days immediately prior to export;*

Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven voor een paard dat officieel geregistreerd staat (bij een stamboek, overkoepelende organisatie, etc.). Voor een paard dat niet officieel geregistreerd is, kan deze verklaring niet worden afgegeven. Belanghebbende dient een verklaring af te geven waaruit blijkt dat het te exporteren paard de laatste 21 dagen voorafgaand aan de export naar de Verenigde Arabische Emiraten heeft verbleven in de Europese Unie (bijlage 4).

**Verklaring 7:**

*On ..... (date) being within 30 days of export, and, if imported into the EU, at least 14 days after the date of entry, blood samples were taken from the said animal and were submitted to testing by an Agar Gel Immunodiffusion (Coggins) Test for Equine Infectious Anaemia, with negative result<sup>(4)</sup>;*

Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van negatieve laboratoriumuitslagen van het te exporteren paard, aan te leveren door belanghebbende.

**Verklaring 8:**

*During the 90 days immediately prior to export, but not within 14 days of export, the horse received:  
Either<sup>(5)</sup> at least two primary vaccinations against equine influenza, given between 21 and 42 apart;  
Dates of vaccination      1:                          2:*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> It received a booster vaccination against equine influenza which was given within 12 months of a certified primary course, or within 12 months of a certified booster vaccination where it, and any other previous booster vaccinations, had been administered annually within a regular 12 month period since the primary course<sup>(6)</sup>;*

*Date of booster vaccination:*

De niet van toepassing zijnde optie dient te worden doorgehaald.

Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van de vaccinatiegegevens in het paardenpaspoort van het te exporteren paard, aan te leveren door belanghebbende. Conform Uitvoeringsverordening (EU) 2015/262 dienen alle vaccinaties te worden vermeld in het paardenpaspoort. De data van de primaire vaccinaties respectievelijk de datum van de boostervaccinatie dient te worden ingevuld.

**Verklaring 10:**

*The equines are fit to travel on the day of inspection;*

Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven na controle door de certificerende NVWA-dierenarts.

**Verklaring 11:**

*I have a written declaration, signed by the owner of the representative, stating that:*

- i. *The horse will be sent from the premises of origin to the Airport of dispatch without coming into contact with other equine animals which do not meet UAE Temporary Import Conditions as specified in this certificate, in a vehicle cleansed and disinfected in advance with a disinfectant officially recognized in the country of dispatch, and;*
- ii. *Either<sup>(5)</sup> The horse will be sent directly from the premises of origin to the Airport of dispatch; Or<sup>(5)</sup> The horse will not be sent directly from the premises of origin to the Airport of dispatch but it will be unloaded at the following premises, en route, and Supplementary Certification in the form specified at Annex B to UAE Import Conditions for the temporary import of horses from the EU, will be provided for each premises<sup>(2)</sup>;*

Het eerste deel (i) van deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van een verklaring van de eigenaar of diens vertegenwoordiger (bijlage 4), waarin wordt verklaard dat het te exporteren paard tijdens het transport van het bedrijf van oorsprong naar het vliegveld niet in contact zal komen met andere paardachtigen die niet voldoen aan de eisen van dit certificaat en zal worden vervoerd in een voertuig dat vooraf is gereinigd en gesdesinfecteerd met een voor dat doel in Nederland toegelaten desinfectiemiddel. De eigenaarsverklaring wordt bij het certificaat gevoegd en een kopie hiervan wordt in de NVWA-administratie bewaard.

Voor het tweede deel (ii) van deze verklaring geldt dat de niet van toepassing zijnde optie dient te worden doorgehaald.

De eerste optie van het tweede deel (ii) van deze verklaring is van toepassing als het paard direct wordt vervoerd van het bedrijf van oorsprong naar het vliegveld, zonder tussenhalte. Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van een verklaring van de eigenaar of diens vertegenwoordiger dat het te exporteren paard direct naar het vliegveld zal worden vervoerd zonder uitgeladen te worden (bijlage 4).

De tweede optie van het tweede deel (ii) van deze verklaring dient altijd te worden doorgehaald. Het betreft een verklaring over een gebeurtenis in de toekomst en dit kan niet worden verklaard door de certificerende NVWA-dierenarts. Het transport dient derhalve altijd direct, zonder uitlading, plaats te vinden.

- Either<sup>(5)</sup> It was imported into the European Union under permanent import conditions as laid down in EC Decision 93/197/EEC (as amended)<sup>(5)</sup>;*
- Or<sup>(5)</sup> To the best of my knowledge and based on a written declaration by the owner/agent, it was not imported into the European Union, in the last 90 days, from a country, other than Australia or New Zealand, listed in Groups B or D of Annex 1 to EC Decision 92/260/EEC on*

*animal health conditions and veterinary certification for temporary admission of registered horses, (as amended);*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> It was subjected to the following blood tests carried out on blood samples collected on ..... (date), being within 30 days of export, and at least 14 days after the date of entry, with negative results;*

*A Complement Fixation Test for Dourine at a dilution of 1 in 10<sup>(4)</sup>;*

*And A Complement Fixation Test for Glanders at a dilution of 1 in 10<sup>(4)</sup>;*

(date) being within 30 days of export, and, if imported into the EU, at least 14 days after the date of entry, blood samples were taken from the said animal and were submitted to testing by an Agar Gel Immunodiffusion (Coggins) Test for Equine Infectious Anaemia, with a negative result<sup>(4)</sup>;*

Deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van negatieve laboratoriumuitslagen van het te exporteren paard, aan te leveren door belanghebbende.

**Verklaring 9:**

*For entire males older than 180 days:*

*Either<sup>(5)</sup> On ..... (date) being within 30 days of export, and, if imported into the EU, at least 14 days after the date of entry, blood samples were taken from the said animal and sent to an E.U. Laboratory approved for export testing by the Competent Authority of a Member State where they were submitted to testing by a Virus Neutralisation Test for Equine Viral Arteritis with negative results, at a dilution of 1 in 4;*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> On ..... (date) being within 30 days of export, and, if imported into the EU, at least 14 days after the date of entry, an aliquot of its entire semen was taken and submitted to an E.U. Laboratory approved for export testing by the Competent Authority of a Member State where it was tested by Virus Isolation Tests for Equine Viral Arteritis (at least 3 passages) with negative results;*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> It was vaccinated on ..... (date) against Equine Viral Arteritis, under Official Veterinary Supervision with a vaccine approved by the Competent Authority, according to the following programme for initial vaccination and, where appropriate, has since been re-vaccinated at regular intervals, as recommended by the vaccine manufacturers<sup>(3)</sup>;*

*Programmes for initial vaccination against Equine Viral Arteritis<sup>(7)</sup>:*

*Either<sup>(5)</sup> Vaccination was carried out on the day a blood sample was taken that subsequently proved negative in a virus neutralization test for Equine Viral Arteritis at a dilution of 1 in 4;*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> Vaccination was carried out during a period of isolation of not more than 15 days under official veterinary supervision, commencing on the day a blood sample was taken that was tested during that time with negative result in a Virus Neutralization test for Equine Viral Arteritis at a dilution of 1 in 4;*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> Vaccination was carried out when the animal was at an age of 180 to 270 days, during a period of isolation under official veterinary supervision. During the isolation period two blood samples taken at least 10 days apart proved a stable or declining antibody titre in a virus neutralization test for Equine Viral Arteritis;*

Als negatieve laboratoriumuitslag wordt aangemerkt een negatieve uitslag bij een verdunning van maximaal 1:4 (dit betekent dat het onderzochte paard dus serologisch positief is wanneer het serum bij een verdunning van 1:4 of hoger in staat is EVA te neutraliseren). De datum waarop de monsters genomen zijn, dient te worden ingevuld.

De tweede optie van deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van de negatieve laboratoriumuitslagen van het te exporteren paard, aan te leveren door belanghebbende. De datum waarop het sperma is verzameld, dient te worden ingevuld.

De derde optie van deze verklaring kan worden afgegeven op basis van vaccinatiegegevens en de bijbehorende laboratoriumuitslagen van het te exporteren paard, aan te leveren door belanghebbende. Bij deze optie dient ook te worden aangegeven welk van de toegestane vaccinatieschema's is gebruikt. De niet van toepassing zijnde vaccinatieschema's dienen te worden doorgehaald. De datum van vaccinatie dient te worden ingevuld.

*During the 60 days immediately prior to export, but not within 14 days of export, the horse received:*

*Either<sup>(5)</sup> at least two primary vaccinations against equine influenza, given between 21 and 42 apart  
Dates of vaccination: 1: 2:*

*Or<sup>(5)</sup> it received a booster vaccination against equine influenza which was given within 12 months of a certified primary course, or within 12 months of a certified booster vaccination where it, and any other previous booster vaccinations, had been administered annually within a regular 12 month period since the primary course<sup>(6)</sup>;*

*Date of booster vaccination:*

*I have a written declaration, signed by the owner of the representative, stating that:*

*i. The horse will be sent from the premises of origin to the Airport of dispatch without coming into contact with other equine animals which do not meet UAE Temporary Import Conditions as specified in this certificate, in a vehicle cleansed and disinfected in advance with a disinfectant officially recognized in the country of dispatch, and;*

*ii. Either<sup>(5)</sup> The horse will be sent directly from the premises of origin to the Airport of dispatch;
